

***4.1 and 5.1 apply to T and L Recycled Filler**

Potential LEED® Credits

Credit 4.1: Recycled Content (1-point)

Use materials with recycled content such that the sum of post-consumer recycled content plus $\frac{1}{2}$ pre-consumer recycled content constitutes at least 5% of the total value of the materials in the project.

Credit 4.2: Recycled Content (1-point)

Use materials with recycled content such that the sum of post-consumer recycled content plus $\frac{1}{2}$ pre-consumer recycled content constitutes at least 10% of the total value of the materials in the project.

Credit 5.1: Local/Regional Materials (1-point)

Use a minimum of 20% of building materials and products that are manufactured regionally within a radius of 500 miles.

Credit 5.2: Local/Regional Materials (1-point)

Of the regionally manufactured building materials in Level 1, use a minimum of 50% of building materials and products that are extracted, harvested or recovered (as well as manufactured) within a radius of 500 miles.

Credit 1.1: Innovation in Design (1-4 points)

Example: Possible credit for use of alternate transportation for distribution of materials from manufacturer to site resulting in a decreased usage of fossil fuel.
